LMACCC Child Hand Sanitizer Permission Form

The Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) requires written permission for child use of hand sanitizer. Hand sanitizer can be utilized when a sink for hand washing with soap and water is not available. EEC encourages the use of hand sanitizer with alcohol content of 60% or higher for children upon arrival to the entrance of the center when developmentally appropriate, and children will be supported to wash their hands upon arrival to their classroom. It may also be used during transitions and on the playground. Hands will always be washed with soap and water upon returning to the classroom.

Hand sanitizer is always kept out of the reach of children. Children will be monitored closely with its use to make sure they rub their hands completely dry, so they do not get sanitizer in their eyes or mouth.
